There will be singing and dancing on a big stage.

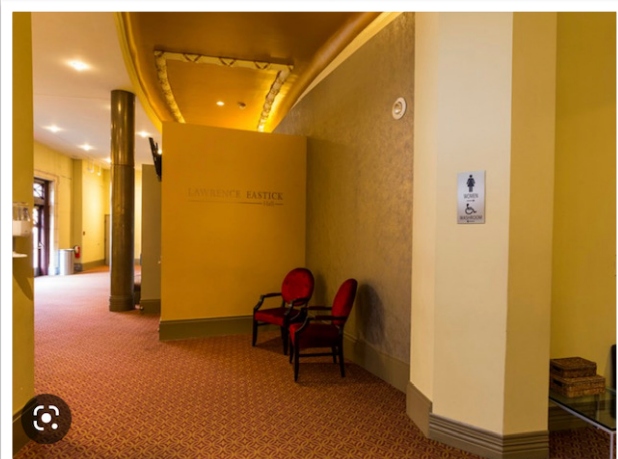
You will walk in the big glass doors.

Summary of the show: Joseph and the Technicolor Dreamcoat tells the story of Joseph, a boy who receives a bright, multicoloured coat from his father. His eleven brothers grow jealous and send him away to Egypt. Even though Joseph faces many challenges, he stays hopeful and discovers he can understand dreams. His gift helps him rise from being a servant to becoming a trusted advisor to the Pharaoh. When a famine hits, Joseph's brothers come to Egypt for help, not realizing he is now an important leader. Instead of staying angry, Joseph forgives them and saves his family, showing the power of kindness and courage.
